

Fran Morris Award Guidelines MCH Nurse

This award is named after Fran Morris, in recognition of her contribution to, and promotion of, maternal and child health nursing.

Purpose: For the continued recognition of outstanding contributions to maternal and child health nursing practice by maternal and child health nurses. To promote maternal and child health nursing practice and encourage student maternal and child health nurses to aspire to a career in maternal and child health nursing practice.

Criteria: The annual prize of \$250 is awarded to the nurse who has clearly demonstrated a commitment to promoting the professional, educational, economic or social interests of maternal and child health nurses.

Eligibility Nominations are by written submission by one or more of the nominee's colleagues.

Nominations will be accepted for maternal and child health nurses practicing in Victoria and maternal and child health nurses who have recently retired (during the previous year).

The nominee must be a current financial member of the Victorian Association of Maternal and Child Health Nurses. Conditions of the Award Nominations must be made on the Victorian Association of Maternal and Child Health Nurses 'Fran Morris Award Nomination Form' and be received by the designated closing date.

Late nominations will not be considered.

Submissions are to address the above criteria and should be no more than 500 words.

Submissions will not be returned, please keep a copy. Submissions are required for publication in 'The VAMCHN' Newsletter and/or on the website.

Selection Criteria Assessment and selection of the winner/s will be made by the Executive Committee based on how well the submission meets the criteria.

The decision of VAMCHN Executive Committee will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

CLOSING DATE FOR NOMINATIONS: 16th October 2020.

The winner/s of the award will be announced at the AGM on 1st December 2020.

If VAMCHN Executive Committee believes there are no suitable nominees, the prize will be held over until the following year.
